

RealSAM Smart Speaker

You can now use your Google Home or Alexa device to access the world's first dedicated smart speaker information hub for blind and visually impaired people.

Offering masses of content from UK sight-loss charities, the subscription service includes books, newspapers, podcasts and radio stations, all in one place for the first time.

The [RealSAM](#) smart speaker is a fully voice controlled media player tool that you can add to your home device. The platform currently hosts content from leading UK sight loss charities such as Henshaws, Galloways and Torch Trust, but they are keen to grow. They are looking to expand and add content from visually impaired communities or others who need to operate technology fully by voice.

The platform is available now for £9.95 for an annual subscription for existing RealSAM customers, and an annual launch offer for new customers of £19.90. Users can search by asking their device to 'Talk to RealSAM' or go to rnib.org.uk for more information.
