

The TREATWOLFRAM trial stayed open in BWCH but it was decided not to randomise patients in April, to avoid any unnecessary risk of exposure to Coronavirus. BWCH fortunately saw far fewer cases than our colleagues in QE hospital, and those we did see, all made a good recovery. Recruitment restarted in June, as the risks were judged to be sufficiently low to continue. If the situation in the hospital remains good, we hope to recruit the next patient towards the end of the Summer. The research nurses at both QEH and BWCH have been working flat out to deliver studies around finding treatments for Covid, so please bear with us while they build up their capacity for non-Covid studies again. We would like to reassure families that both our children's and adult hospitals are safety conscious and participants will only be invited to attend if Drs Wight and Dias judge it safe to do so.
