TREATWolfram Adult Trial update 12th June 2020

After a hopeful start to the year by opening the QE hospital in Birmingham as a recruitment site to the TREATWOLFRAM clinical trial, recruitment was then paused due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The QE hospital underwent rapid change to ensure the necessary preparations were made to manage this with redeployment of staff from their usual roles and closure of non-acute clinical hospital sites. This impacted the delivery of many services including research related activity. Preparations are now underway to restart this trial, with changes to be made at the hospital to ensure it can restart as safely as possible. Whilst the exact date when this trail will re-open is not yet known, it has been agreed that the reopening of TREATWOLFRAM will be prioritised.
